 - Heatstroke, Hypothermia & Frost bite
 - Wasp & bee stings and snake bites
 - Burns and scolds
 - Choking and drowning
 - Haemorrhage & wounds
- Bandaging
- Administer CPR
- Transporting and handling an injured dog
